Club Notes

GOOD RUN TO CONTINUE ? With all due respect to our old friends from Chesterfield whom we welcome to-day, it is hoped that the answer to that question is a resounding 'yes.' Starting with our home game against Crewe we are unbeaten, a run of six matches which has brought in 11 points. And we have, of course, won all four league games at Haig Avenue. We were made to fight hard for our victory by Notts County on Monday night and another hard struggle is anticipated this afternoon. Chesterfield are making their 26th league visit to our ground. Of the past games we have won 15, Chesterfield six with four drawn. Seven of our victories have come since the war and we have won the last two, although on each occasion we have had to be content with a lone goal. You can see how close the issues have been as we have scored 35 goals in the 25 previous matches and Chesterfield 20. Chesterfield have averaged a point a game to date, gaining three points at home and three away. Their first home game was in the Football League Cup when they beat Third Division Scunthorpe 2-1. Then they defeated Lincoln 3-1 but suffered a lone goal defeat at the hands of Newport and took part in a goalless draw with Rochdale last Saturday. On tour Chesterfield drew 1-1 at York, won 3-0 at Barnsley and then were defeated 1-3 at Stockport before going down by the odd goal in five in the second round of the League cup at York. In their eight matches, Chesterfield have scored 12 goals and had 10 scored against them, their marksmen being Hollett (five), Stark and Bartley (two each), Clarke, Randall, and Anderson (one each).

STIFF WEEK AHEAD. We realise full well that we have a stiff week ahead when we visit teams with unbeaten home records. On Wednesday we visit Aldershot for the return meeting, having won 1-0 at home and on Friday we are at Stockport County, who pip us for first place at present on goal average.
